Create a sculpture using locally recyclable materials

CATEGORIES

- 4th to 6th grade: \$30, \$20, \$10 prizes
- 7th to 8th grade: \$30, \$20, \$10 prizes
- 9th to 12th grade: \$30, \$20, \$10 prizes
- Adult: \$30, \$20, \$10 prizes
- People's Choice: \$50 Award
- Local Businesses: Certificate Awards

GUIDELINES

- **AGES:** Open to 4th grade to 100 years of age.
- **THEME:** Entries should be planned around the Earth Week theme "Restore Our Earth: Ecosystem Restoration and Green Technology."
Educational material about habitat restoration and green technology will be found at envirofair.org/contests/ by 2/13.
- **USE RECYCLABLE MATERIALS:** Create the art sculpture with locally sourced recyclable materials.
- **ENTRY DISPLAYS:** Sculpture entries shall be brought to Lookout Point between 9:30 a.m. and 10:00 a.m. on April 18.
- **VOTING/JUDGING:** Event attendees may vote throughout the day for one sculpture using the "Voting Ticket" received at any fair entrance booth. A judges' panel will decide winners based on criteria for age categories and business competitions. Judging will begin at 1:15 p.m. The People's Choice award will be presented to the sculpture receiving the greatest number of votes from fair attendees. Winners will be announced from the bandshell at 1:45 pm!
- **REMOVAL: REMEMBER TO PICK UP YOUR ENTRY AT 3 PM!** Sculptors will collect their sculptures from Lookout Point between 3 p.m. and 3:15 p.m.

JUDGING CRITERIA

- Relevance to theme.
- Number of Recyclable Categories used (i.e., wood, paper, plastic, metals—glass and duct tape are NOT permitted)
- % of sculpture made from recycled materials
- Originality (sculpture can be realistic or abstract)
- Design and artistic impact ("WOW" factor)
- Complexity of sculpture
